Adherence to Antipsychotic Medications for Individuals With Schizophrenia (SAA)

Measure evaluates members 18 years of age and older during the measurement year with schizophrenia or schizoaffective disorder who were dispensed and remained on an antipsychotic medication for at least 80% of their treatment period.

Antidepressant Medication Management

Measure evaluates members age 18 years of age and older who were treated with antidepressant medication, had a diagnosis of major depression, and who remained on an antidepressant medication treatment.

Two rates reported:

Effective Acute Phase Treatment:

Members who remained on an antidepressant medication for at least 84 days (12 weeks).

Effective Continuation Phase Treatment:

Members who remained on an antidepressant medication for at least 180 days (six months).

Follow-Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH)

Measure evaluates the percentage of discharges for members 6 years of age and older who were hospitalized for treatment of selected mental illness or intentional self-harm diagnoses and who had a follow-up visit with a mental health practitioner.

Two rates reported:

Seven-Day Follow Up:

Members who had a follow-up visit with a mental health practitioner within seven days of discharge.

30-Day Follow Up:

Members who had a follow-up visit with a mental health practitioner within 30 days of discharge.

* Do not include visits that occur on the date of discharge
