## Diabetes Short-Term Complications Admission Rate



### Measure Overview

The rate of inpatient admissions for diabetes short-term complications (ketoacidosis, hyperosmolarity, coma) per 100,000 beneficiary months for adults 19 and older. A lower rate means better performance.

### Who Is Included

- Members aged 19 and older
- Any enrollment during the measurement period

### Compliance Criteria

A member is compliant if they have no inpatient discharge with a principal diagnosis of diabetes short-term complications.

### Exclusions

- Transfers from hospitals, SNFs, ICFs, other facilities
- Ungroupable DRG
- Missing age, year, or principal diagnosis
- Obstetric discharges

### Provider Tips

1. Ensure regular monitoring (e.g., HbA1c every six months)
2. Adjust medications promptly
3. Provide strong patient education
4. Reinforce adherence to care plans
5. Use care coordination and case management
