Coding & Documentation

Status Codes¹

Condition status codes are commonly overlooked. It is important to completely document all condition details and assign the correct diagnosis code.

- Status codes indicate that a patient is either a carrier of a disease or has Status codes should be reported for all encounters that document the the sequelae or residual of a past disease or condition. The status may affect treatment of other conditions and overall health outcome.
 - status as a factor in medical decision making and/or during a well exam at least once per calendar year as long as the status exists.
