Breast Cancer Screening

Women 50–74 years of age who had one or more mammograms between October 1 two years prior to the measurement year and December 31 of the measurement year.

Exclusions:

- Bilateral mastectomy
- Unilateral mastectomy
- Two unilateral mastectomies with service dates 14 or more days apart
- History of bilateral mastectomy

Colorectal Cancer Screening

Members 50–75 years of age who had appropriate screening for colorectal cancer. Medical record must include a note indicating the date when the colorectal cancer screening was performed. A result is not required if the documentation in the medical record is clear that the test was performed and not merely ordered. *The following screenings meet criteria:*

- Fecal Occult Blood Testing during the measurement year. (common names: FIT or Guaiac)
- Flexible Sigmoidoscopy during the measurement year or four years prior to the measurement year.
- Colonoscopy during the measurement year or the nine years prior to the measurement year.
- CT Colonography during the measurement year or the four years prior to the measurement year. Must be done by CT (MRI does not count)
- FIT-DNA test during the measurement year or the two years prior to the measurement year.

Patients who have a history of colon cancer (c18.0-18.9, C19-C20, C21.2, C21.8, C78.5, Z85.038 or Z85.048) or who have had a total colectomy are exempt from this measure.

Controlling Blood Pressure

Members 18–85 years of age who had a diagnosis of hypertension (HTN) and whose BP was adequately controlled during the measurement year based on the following criteria:

- Members 18–59 years of age whose BP was <140/90 mm Hg
- Members 60–85 years of age with a diagnosis of diabetes whose BP was <140/90 mm Hg
- Members 60–85 years of age without a diagnosis of diabetes whose BP was <150/90 mm Hg

Diabetes Care (Comprehensive)

Members ages 18-75 with diabetes (types 1 & 2) who were compliant in the following sub measures:

Eye Exam: Member has 1 retinal or dilated eye exam by an eye care professional (optometrist or ophthalmologist) during the measurement year. Member had 1 negative retinal or dilated eye exam, negative for retinopathy, by an eye care professional (optometrist or ophthalmologist) during the previous measurement year.

Medication Reconciliation Post Discharge (MRP)

Measure evaluates the percentage of discharges from January 1-December 1 of the measurement year for **members age 18 and older** for whom medications at discharge were reconciled against the outpatient medical record on or within 30 days of discharge. Submit codes to identify the presence of a list of medications from the discharge summary:

Members 18 years of age and older who were diagnosed with rheumatoid arthritis and who were dispensed at least one ambulatory prescription for a disease-modifying anti-rheumatic drug (DMARD)
